#### Common Alloy Aluminum Sheet From the Sultanate of Oman: Preliminary Results of Antidumping Duty Administrative Review; 2023–2024

**AGENCY:** Enforcement and Compliance, International Trade Administration, Department of Commerce.

**SUMMARY:** The U.S. Department of Commerce (Commerce) preliminarily determines that common alloy aluminum sheet (aluminum sheet) from the Sultanate of Oman (Oman) were made at less than normal value (NV) during the period of review (POR), April 1, 2023, through March 31, 2024. Interested parties are invited to comment on these preliminary results.

#### Background

On April 27, 2021, Commerce published in the **Federal Register** the antidumping duty (AD) order on aluminum sheet from Oman.<sup>1</sup> On April

1, 2024, Commerce published in the **Federal Register** a notice of opportunity to request an administrative review of the *Order* for the period April 1, 2023, through March 31, 2024.<sup>2</sup> On June 12, 2024, based on a timely request for review, in accordance with 19 CFR 351.221(c)(1)(i), we initiated an administrative review of the *Order*.<sup>3</sup> Oman Aluminium Rolling Company (OARC) is the only company subject to this review and thus is the sole mandatory respondent in this administrative review. On July 22, 2024, Commerce tolled certain deadlines in this administrative proceeding by seven days.<sup>4</sup> On December 6, 2024, we extended the deadline for issuing the preliminary results, in accordance with section of 751(a)(3)(A) of the Tariff Act of 1930 (the Act), and 19 CFR 351.213(h)(2).<sup>5</sup> On December 9, 2024, Commerce tolled certain deadlines in this administrative proceeding by an additional 90 days.<sup>4</sup>

For details regarding the events that occurred subsequent to the initiation of this review, see the Preliminary Decision Memorandum.<sup>6</sup> A list of topics discussed in the Preliminary Decision Memorandum is included as the Appendix to this notice. The Preliminary Decision Memorandum is a public document and is on file electronically via Enforcement and Compliance's Antidumping and Countervailing Duty Centralized Electronic Service System (ACCESS). ### Methodology

Commerce is conducting this review in accordance with sections 751(a)(1)(B) and (2) of the Act. Commerce calculated export price in accordance with section 772(a) of the Act. Normal value is calculated in accordance with section 773 of the Act. For a full description of the methodology underlying these preliminary results, see the Preliminary Decision Memorandum.

### Preliminary Results of the Review

We preliminarily determine the following estimated weighted-average dumping margin exists for the period of April 1, 2023, through March 31, 2024:

### Disclosure

Commerce intends to disclose its calculations and analysis performed to interested parties for these preliminary results within five days of any public announcement or, if there is no public announcement, within five days of the date of publication of this notice in accordance with 19 CFR 351.224(b).

### Public Comment

Case briefs or other written comments may be submitted to the Assistant Secretary for Enforcement and Compliance. Pursuant to 19 CFR 351.309(c)(1)(ii), we have modified the deadline for interested parties to submit case briefs to Commerce to no later than 21 days after the date of the publication of this notice.<sup>7</sup> Rebuttal briefs, limited to issues raised in the case briefs, may be filed no later than five days after the date for filing case briefs.<sup>8</sup> Parties who submit case briefs or rebuttal briefs in this proceeding are encouraged to submit with each argument: (1) a statement of the issue; and (2) a table of authorities.<sup>9</sup> All briefs must be filed electronically using ACCESS. An electronically filed document must be received successfully in its entirety in ACCESS by 5:00 p.m. Eastern Time on the established deadline.
