Self-Regulatory Organizations; Cboe BZX Exchange, Inc.; Notice of Filing and Immediate Effectiveness of a Proposed Rule Change To Amend the Fidelity Wise Origin Bitcoin Fund, VanEck Bitcoin ETF, 21Shares Ethereum ETF, Fidelity Ethereum Fund, and the VanEck Ethereum ETF, Shares of Which Were Approved To List and Trade on the Exchange Pursuant to BZX Rule 14.11(e)(4)

Pursuant to Section 19(b)(1) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934

(“Act”),¹ and Rule 19b–4 thereunder,² notice is hereby given that on September 26, 2025, Cboe BZX Exchange, Inc. (the “Exchange” or “BZX”) filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission (the “Commission”) the proposed rule change as described in Items I and II below, which Items have been prepared by the Exchange. The Exchange filed the proposal as a “non-controversial” proposed rule change pursuant to Section 19(b)(3)(A)(iii) of the Act³ and Rule 19b–4(f)(6) thereunder.⁴ The Commission is publishing this notice to solicit comments on the proposed rule change from interested persons.

I. Self-Regulatory Organization’s Statement of the Terms of Substance of the Proposed Rule Change

Cboe BZX Exchange, Inc. (“BZX” or the “Exchange”) is filing with the Securities and Exchange Commission

(“Commission” or “SEC”) a proposed rule change to amend the Fidelity Wise Origin Bitcoin Fund, VanEck Bitcoin ETF,⁵ 21Shares Ethereum ETF,⁶ Fidelity Ethereum Fund, and the VanEck Ethereum ETF,⁷ (collectively, the “Funds”), shares (“Fund Shares”) of which have been approved by the Commission to list and trade on the Exchange pursuant to BZX Rule 14.11(e)(4) under an approval order, to permit the Funds to list and trade under the generic listing standards of that rule effective October 1, 2025.
