l. *Description of Request*: Appalachian Power Company (licensee) requests Commission approval to remove the requirement for the Leesville Tailrace Fishing Platform from the Commission approved Recreation Management Plan and Article 410 of the license, until such time that the Virginia Department of Wildlife Resources obtains appropriate funding and provides engineering plans for consideration by Appalachian Power Company. The Leesville Fishing Platform is a license required-recreation area which was closed in 2019 due to structural safety issues and portion of the platform was removed due to structural and public safety concerns.
