Abstract: Internal Revenue Code (IRC) section 6050H provides that an information return must be made by any person who is engaged in a trade or business and who, during that trade or business, receives from any individual

\$600 or more of interest on any mortgage in a calendar year. Any person required to make an information return under IRC section 6050H also must furnish a statement to the payor of record on or before January 31 of the year following the calendar year in which the interest was received. Form 1098, Mortgage Interest Statement, is used to report mortgage interest (including points) received during the year.

Current Actions: There is no change to the previously approved information collection.

Type of Review: Extension of a currently approved collection.

Affected Public: Business or other for-profit organizations.

Estimated Number of Responses: 75,912,060.
