During the meeting representatives from the shrimp fishery, NMFS, Council staff, Council members, Science and Statistical Committee member, and relevant researchers will review available data and information pertaining to both giant manta rays, smalltooth sawfish, and the South Atlantic federal shrimp fisheries. In addition, they will discuss a list of potential options for bycatch reduction and/or mitigation.
