These regulations are necessary to ensure that certain Type III supporting organizations meet the public charity requirements under IRC section 509(a)(3). Type III supporting organizations, which are the respondents, are responsible for collecting the necessary information from their supported organizations and providing it to the Internal Revenue Service upon request.
