

DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY**Coast Guard****33 CFR Part 165****[Docket No. USCG–2026–0684]****Safety Zones; Annual Events in the Captain of the Port Eastern Great Lakes Zone****AGENCY:** Coast Guard, DHS.**ACTION:** Notification of enforcement of regulation.

SUMMARY: The Coast Guard will enforce multiple safety zones located in federal regulations for recurring marine events taking place in July 2026 to provide for the safety of life on navigable waterways during these events. Our regulation for marine events within the Captain of the Port Eastern Great Lakes zone identifies the regulated areas for these events. During the enforcement periods, the operator of any vessel in the regulated areas must comply with directions from the Captain of the Port Eastern Great Lakes or a designated representative.

DATES: The regulations listed in Table 1 to 33 CFR 165.939 will be enforced for the following regulated areas, at the indicated dates and times:

- *Event (G)(7):* Lorain Independence Day—from 9:15 p.m. through 10:45 p.m. on July 4, 2026.
- *Event (G)(8):* Conneaut Red, White, and Boom Over Lake Erie—from 9:15 p.m. through 11:00 p.m. on July 4, 2026.
- *Event (G)(9):* Fairport Harbor Mardi Gras—from 9:30 p.m. through 11:00 p.m. on July 5, 2026.
- *Event (G)(10):* Sheffield Lake Community Days—from 9:30 p.m. through 10:50 p.m. on July 24, 2026.

SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION: The Coast Guard will enforce The Coast Guard will enforce multiple safety zones for annual events in the Captain of the Port Eastern Great Lakes Zone listed in Table 1 to 33 CFR 165.939, for events occurring in the month of July as listed in the **DATES** section above. Pursuant to 33 CFR 165.23, entry into, transiting, or anchoring within these safety zones during an enforcement period is prohibited unless authorized by the Captain of the Port (COTP) Eastern Great

Lakes or his designated representative. Those seeking permission to enter the safety zone may request permission from the COTP Eastern Great Lakes via channel 16, VHF–FM. Vessels and persons granted permission to enter the safety zone shall obey the directions of COTP Eastern Great Lakes or his designated representative. While within a safety zone, all vessels shall operate at the minimum speed necessary to maintain a safe course.

In addition to this notice of enforcement in the **Federal Register**, the Coast Guard will provide the maritime community with advance notification of this enforcement period via Broadcast Notice to Mariners or Local Notice to Mariners. If the COTP Eastern Great Lakes determines that the safety zone need not be enforced for the full duration stated in this notice, he may use a Broadcast Notice to Mariners to grant general permission to enter the respective safety zone.

SUMMARY: The Coast Guard will enforce the safety zone for the Put-In-Bay 4th of July Fireworks in Put-In-Bay, OH, from 9:30 p.m. to 11 p.m. on July 4, 2026, to protect the safety of life and property on the navigable waters immediately prior to, during, and immediately after this event. During the enforcement period, no person or vessel may enter the safety zone without permission of the COTP Detroit or a designated representative.

DATES: The regulations in 33 CFR 165.941 will be enforced for the location identified in item (2) of Table 2, from 9:30 p.m. through 11 p.m. on July 4, 2026.

SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION: The Coast Guard will enforce the safety zone listed in item (2) of Table 2 to 33 CFR 165.941 for the Put-In-Bay 4th of July Fireworks event in Put-In-Bay, OH, from 9:30 p.m. to 11 p.m. on July 4, 2026. This action is being taken to provide for the safety of life on certain navigable waters of Lake Erie in the vicinity of Put-In-Bay. Our regulation for recurring marine events within the Captain of the Port Detroit Zone in § 165.941 specifies the location of the regulated area, in item (2) to Table 2. During the enforcement period, if you are the operator of a vessel in the regulated area, you must comply with directions from the Patrol Commander or any Official Patrol displaying a Coast Guard ensign.
