FSIS has been delegated the authority to exercise the functions of the Secretary as provided in the Federal Meat Inspection Act (FMIA) (21 U.S.C. 601 *et seq.*). This statute mandates that FSIS protect the public by ensuring that meat products are safe, wholesome, and properly labeled.

Need and Use of the Information: FSIS will collect information from establishments to verify that meat products produced through the use of Advanced Meat Recovery (AMR) systems are free from Bovine Spongiform Encephalopathy (BSE).
