Black Canyon Hydro, LLC; Notice of Availability of the Final Environmental Impact Statement for the Seminole Pumped Storage Project

In accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969¹ and the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's (Commission) regulations, 18 CFR part 380, the Office of Energy Projects has reviewed the application for license for the Seminole Pumped Storage Project (FERC No. 14787) and has prepared a final environmental impact statement (EIS) for the project. The 972-megawatt project would be located at the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation's (Reclamation) Seminole Reservoir on the North Platte River in Carbon County, Wyoming, approximately 35 miles northeast of Rawlins, Wyoming. The project would occupy 1,043.9 acres of land managed by the Bureau of Land Management (BLM), 88.2 acres managed by Reclamation, and 831.7 acres of private lands. Reclamation, BLM, the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, the Western Area Power Administration, the Saratoga-Encampment-Rawlins Conservation District, the Medicine Bow Conservation District, and the Carbon County Board
