

illegal marketing and advertising; (4) distribution of free samples of tobacco products except in limited circumstances; (5) placement of cigarette or smokeless tobacco product vending machines in prohibited areas (or providing access to self-service or direct access of tobacco products in prohibited areas); (6) the manufacture or sale of unauthorized tobacco products; and (7) sale of cigarettes in packages of less than 20.

FDA currently provides a form that may be used to collect this information from the public (Form FDA 3779, Potential Tobacco Product Violations Report). The Potential Tobacco Product Violations Report, Form FDA 3779, asks for the following information: (1) date

potential violation occurred; (2) product type (e.g., cigarette, smokeless, roll-your-own, cigar, e-cigarette, hookah, pipe tobacco); (3) tobacco brand; (4) potential violation type; (5) type of potentially violative promotional materials; (6) description of the potential violation (7) who potentially violated; (8) name and address of the potential violator (if known); (9) potential violator's website or internet address URL (if available); (10) Optional filer contact information if additional information is needed or to receive notification the complaint was received; and (11) any additional files or information pertinent to the potential violation.

The public and interested stakeholders can report possible tobacco product violations of the FD&C Act by submitting information on Form FDA 3779 online, via email or postal mail, or by calling FDA's Tobacco Call Center. The burden hour estimates for this collection of information were based on the type and rate of reporting submitted through the Potential Tobacco Violation Report Form and based on a review of the information collection since our last request for OMB approval. FDA estimates that submitting the information (online, telephone, email, or mail) will take 0.25 hours (i.e., 15 minutes) per response.

FDA estimates the number of annual respondents to this collection of information will be 3,000, who will each submit 2 reports. Each report is expected to take 0.25 hours to complete and submit; therefore, total burden hours for this collection of information is estimated to be 1,500 hours (6,000 responses × 0.25 hours per response).
