l. *Description of Request:* In 2022, Domtar Paper Company, LLC (licensee) retired, in place, five inoperable turbine-generator units (Units 1, 2, 4, 5, and 6). The other two turbine generating units at the project (Units 3 and 7) remain in service. Due to newly available energy incentives from the Focus on Energy program in the State of Wisconsin, the licensee proposes to return Unit 5 to service by repairing the unit and reconnecting the generator leads. The proposed upgrades would not result in any ground disturbance and would not require the licensee to deviate from the licensed reservoir elevations or required operations during construction or operation. With both the powerhouse

and the spillway section of the dam releasing flows into the main channel of the Wisconsin River downstream, the proposal would result in an increased flow through the powerhouse and a reduced flow over the spillway. The proposal would increase the installed capacity of the project from 948 to 1,748 kilowatts and would increase the maximum hydraulic capacity from 1,100 to 1,850 cubic feet per second.
