II. Background and Purpose

When did the Coast Guard conduct this port access route study (PARS)?

We conducted this PARS following our announcement in a notice published in the **Federal Register** (FR) on March 1, 2023, entitled “Port Access Route Study: Approaches to Galveston Bay and Sabine Pass, Texas and Calcasieu Pass, Louisiana,” (88 FR 12966). The public was afforded a 47-day comment period. On March 28, 2023, we published a supplemental notice of study, to correct agency contact information and extend the comment period an additional 10 days (88 FR 18326).

The Coast Guard received seven comments to this document in response to our **Federal Register** notice. All comments and supporting documents to this document are available in a public docket and can be viewed by searching docket number USCG–2023–0063 at <http://www.regulations.gov>. A synopsis of the comments and copies of the Coast Guard Heartland District's public outreach can be found in the report.
