k. *Description of Request:* The applicant proposes to amend the project to delete the 79.5-mile-long Tyee-Petersburg transmission line from the project license. The applicant states that with the construction of the connected Swan-Tyee Intertie, the Tyee-Petersburg line is no longer a primary transmission line for the Tyee Lake Hydroelectric Project and is not part of the licensed project. The applicant does not propose any changes to the line beyond administratively removing it from the license, and would continue to operate and maintain the line as it has done in the past. Jurisdiction over the

transmission line right-of-way would convert to the current landowners.
